1 Introduction

Additional functions like IP camera, answering machine or synchronisation can be activated via activation codes.

It is possible to provision activation codes for this function. Subsequently, the corresponding functions will be activated automatically.

2 Provisioning file

2.1 Tags

The activation must be initiated via **<activation>** tag to name the functions to be activated including the corresponding activation codes.

For this, the following tags are available:

<ipcam>

<synchronisation>
